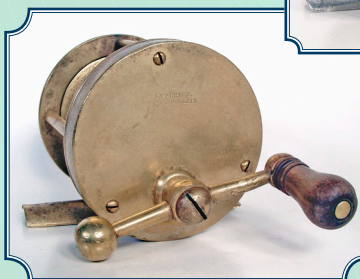
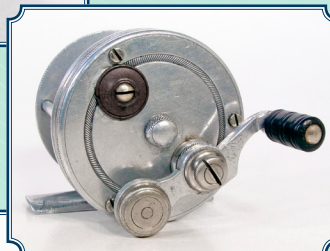
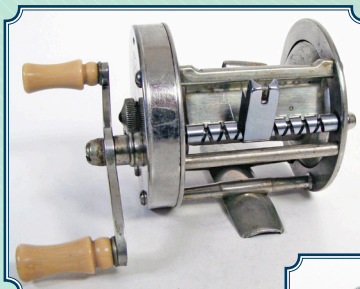

The Reel News

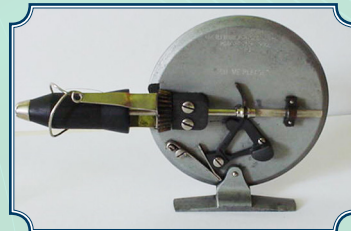
